TERMS & CONDITIONS

General

These terms and conditions, together with any other written information brought to your attention, shall form the basis of your contract with Brag Enterprises Limited (a company incorporated in Scotland, under No: SC068995 with its registered office at Crosshill Business Centre, Main Street, Crosshill, Lochgelly, KY5 8BJ) ('us', 'we' or the 'Company') in respect of the purchase of lottery tickets and any other goods and services we may provide. For the avoidance of doubt, 'written' or 'in writing' shall, where used in these terms and conditions, include email. Please read these terms and conditions carefully and contact us if you have any queries.

None of these terms and conditions are intended to contravene or contradict the Consumer Rights Act 2015 and your statutory rights under any such legislation are not affected.

Online Bookings

We endeavour to ensure that the information and prices, which are inclusive of any applicable taxes, on our website are accurate; however occasionally changes and errors occur and we reserve the right to correct prices and other details in such circumstances.

Once full payment is made, you will be allocated a place(s) and / or ticket and a booking confirmation will be emailed to you. We accept no responsibility for the incorrect inputting of an email address on the booking form, so if you do not receive email confirmation of your booking, please contact us. Upon receipt of the booking confirmation email, it is your responsibility to check the accuracy of dates booked.

Once purchased online, tickets may not be used in conjunction with any other offer. No ticket may be re-sold.

Any discounts or offers online are available for limited quantities and periods only and shall not be available on bookings made by phone or in person.

Please ensure you bring your booking reference number with you.

Lottery Tickets

A minimum of five lottery tickets may be purchased at any one time on this site. Should you wish to purchase four or fewer tickets, this may be done in person from one of our vendors. Please be aware that we are unable to refund any lottery sales so please check the draw date and numbers carefully before checking out. You must be resident in the United Kingdom or Isle of Man and over the age of sixteen.

Tickets can be purchased via our website or in person with one of our local vendors.

You should check the current price and all other details relating to the draw before you buy your ticket(s).

Your ticket is not confirmed until we have issued your receipt. At that point, a binding contract will be entered into between us.

Lottery tickets may be purchased until 11:59pm on the day before the draw (Thursday). The draw will be held on each Friday afternoon from 30 July 2021 unless otherwise stated and will be broadcast over online / social media channels. You will pick six numbers to play.

Winning Tickets

Prizes will be paid out to customers matching six numbers, five and four correct numbers. You must check the numbers drawn and claim your prize by midnight on the following Wednesday, i.e. five days after the date of the draw. Please be aware that we cannot pay out on late claims under any circumstances. It is your responsibility to claim for a win. Taxes

Lottery tickets are currently outside the scope of value added tax, as of the date of these terms and conditions (July 2021).

License and Promoter

Changes/Cancellation by Us

While the Company shall do everything reasonably possible to provide the draw as planned, the Company reserves the right to cancel under exceptional circumstances, such as weather, acts of God and events outwith our control. In such cases, you will be promptly informed and offered:

- to take part in an alternative draw, if we are able to offer that, or
- to cancel your booking and obtain a full refund of all monies paid by you.

Children and Young Persons

Persons under the age of sixteen may not play this lottery. If we become aware that somebody under the age of sixteen has taken part, we will void the ticket and may take action and retain information to prevent future participation.

Publicity

We will request that winners allow us to publicise their name and images. You have the option to withhold consent to publicity.

Data Protection

In order to process your booking, we will need to use the personal information which you provide to us (such as your name, address, contact details, etc). We may also use the information provided to keep in touch with you and to advise you of Together Levenmouth's products and services (including special offers) from time to time. We will not, however, pass your information on to anyone who is not involved in providing (or arranging the provision of) any product or service related to your purchase. Unless expressly stated otherwise in these terms and conditions, we will not have any liability to you if we are prevented from fulfilling our contractual obligations to you as a result of any event which is out with our control. Enforceability of Terms

If any provision of these terms and conditions is found to be illegal or unenforceable, that shall not affect the validity and enforceability of the remainder of these terms and conditions.

Our Liability to You

If you suffer losses as a result of a breach by us of these terms, our liability is strictly limited to the purchase price of the ticket. We are not responsible for any loss of profit, loss of business, loss of goodwill, or any indirect, special or consequential loss, damage, costs, expenses or other claims which arise in connection with the lottery.

Governing Law and Jurisdiction

These terms and conditions shall be governed by and construed in accordance with Scots law and any matter or claim arising from them shall be dealt with only by the Scottish courts (save that you may choose the law and the courts of England, Wales, Northern Ireland or Eire if you live in any of those places and wish to do so).
